




WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

This year, RAKS has been in the community sector for a few years. We have been working in the field of women's rights & equality. Women in our society are always considered by several social evils. India is an ancient place of traditions and customs which has been corrupted with a patriarchal system of the society.

In our institution, Rajashri Sampark Kalyan Samarthan organizes several activities for the voice of women. We are being determined and committed for women empowerment. RAKS organizes and manages several programs for women in their individual manner.

The programs 2017-2018 organized by RAKS for the same are listed below:

Women Self-Help Group

April-June is the monsoon of the Indian subcontinent. It causes flooding due to which the land becomes extremely difficult to cultivate. In such circumstances, people face lack of food and water. Hence, the government has declared these areas as zones of flood-affected regions. After June and successive rainfall, the water level increases and the agricultural economy of such regions has been declared as 'Flood Zones'.

RAKS worked to assist them through some new opportunities of employment like hand-woven. RAKS has developed the setting of unity among all women and provided them with financial and social support. Under this program, local women were associated together through self-help groups and joined them.

POKS, Gram Vikas Foundation and ILDIL Bank, have organized units to run several self-help groups. POKS has established more than 280 self-help groups in different rural areas in the country. POKS provided technical assistance to the members of the self-help groups to establish self-reliant units. POKS women unit has employment units doing handicrafts, dairy agriculture, animal husbandry, small, medium size units and other self-reliant enterprises. In addition to the POKS scheme, there are various self-help units, like a tailoring unit, a library unit, other enterprises. POKS women members of all the projects under the scheme of the organization, especially rural women & their spouses and their children are educated and encouraged. The organization runs such programs also developed the funds supporting its member units from time to time in their entrepreneurial activities.

EDUCATION



Unknown Right To Education activists from the Kharai Gram Panchayat in Jharkhand have come forward to highlight how the government has failed to implement mandatory rules and ensure its policies, which are supposed to provide free and compulsory education as a right, do not reach the most vulnerable groups. The lower gender ratio of 100 students, with regard to the national average.

In order to address the discrimination in education and inequality, Right To Education activists are demanding that the government increase the number of schools and teachers.

Pathshala

In the town of Durgapur, Jharkhand, Suganya Kalyan Sankar has provided free quality Sanskrit-based education to deprived and poor communities. Right To Education "Pathshala" in Taldihia area, where there are 210 students educated here.

The organization also gives poor rural children study material in the ghatas so that they may come to Pujrahali regularly and have a good start in life. About 1,000 students are given quality knowledge-oriented educational and vocational training and 1000 children in the coastal areas are given free primary education.

Udan

Pragya organized Udan, dedicated to female rural women. In this format of education on Micro-enterprise, the rural women learn to sew and make an "Udan" - the 2nd 25 Indian rural women who are learning leather-handicrafts and other skills in making leather goods, leather construction and its selection by the local market society by making use of Udan "improvisation and research and expertise." "Udan" has made an excellent change, because to the rural women more interest is there in leather craft.

But in the beginning, these women faced some problems, but they followed the way of education by hard work and determination to overcome the problem, and now they have opened the business.

Financial Literacy Program

Sustainable Livelihood



Vocational Education

Today, India is moving down at a very rapid country as far as women's empowerment is concerned. Women are emerging as a significant segment in the population and their contribution to the economic development of the country is increasing. In the last decade, REKSHIKA has been providing vocational training for the development of women and girls through which they may be able to access the resources of sustainable livelihoods.

This year, REKSHIKA provided skill development training in different trades. It found that 70% young girls wanted to learn skills after their education to be employed. REKSHIKA has conducted diversified one-month camps. These include tailoring, embroidery, saree stitching, lace work, kashish, lace making, hand embroidery and garment making. Training in these skills has been set up in various districts of Bihar. Through these courses, women will have a sustainable source of livelihood and can earn their bread and butter.

REKSHIKA also arranges the tenth day camp and training camp for young girls in Bihar districts, during which our trainers combine theory and practical classes both that assist the students to learn the skills easily.

During the training, we provide basic training to the girls. REKSHIKA capacity building unit also provides training in the subjects like, culture, life skills and soft working capacity & efficiency. The organization also organizes job fairs, exhibitions and awareness drives through which the trainees get the knowledge of market and help them to practice self-employment skills.

Sustainable Livelihood

The following opening training has conducted some positive changes in the lives of the participants. The beneficiaries after completed the training now started new and good in them are established self-employment at their places. The positive changes strengthen which supports the society as now women also have some opportunities of self-employment than were in different sectors of the society are having the identity.

Women's self-employment has been increasing in their names. For employment and price themselves, and this helps to meet their social needs in the society. Now the society is changing its approach and women also have significant role in making our society safe.

Skills for the self-employment in the self-development training gives confidence to the beneficiaries wherein they help them to be better opportunities.





Environment & Sanitation

The world is suffering from unpredictable change of climate and greater warming at present. As a consequence of industrialization and urbanization, air has been polluted more than ever before, creating the problem of increased temperature of global level, and the increased temperatures have been associated with health problems and the environment. Adopt a Tree

Due to industrial revolution and reckless deforestation our environment is continuously declining and getting destroyed. In order to protect it, Government has started a project by Government, NEMA organized and implemented tree planting system. Under the project in the organization planted more than 550000 trees and by the end of the year 2009, in the current year of road side, temple, government buildings, hospitals and other places. In a location under the concerning person appointed the office of 25X9 and taking initiative they planted trees in their surroundings on the road.



In the course of the year 2009, NEMA organized workshop in 72 different places where the importance of environment and environment was discussed at the participants and collected messages to plant more and more trees.

During winter season losses caused due to sparrows because the little innocent bird is at the verge of extinction. To stop spreading trouble and reducing sparrows' life, innocent and less bird is required job to further now to aid the reduction of its population.

By, Jonathan Samgaji, Kalenjin Socialian has an initiative for the conservation of environment through Sparrow Sparrows. Under this program NEMA put efforts to reduce bird's deaths by installing nest-hanging nests. This year, we installed more than 3000000000+ units of different types of nest-hanging nests. Temple, residential buildings etc. In result, we have positive results of the program very soon which consists of sparrows laying eggs in the eco-friendly nests and reduced bird's mortality.

CHILDREN RIGHT & WELFARE




The poor and helpless children face a world where they are excluded from the mainstream of the society who contributes a lot of our society. But, the society ignores such poor and helpless children and these children are forced to adapt to survive. The children being deprived of basic facilities hardly manage to make it through.

Rejithra Sampriti Kalyan Sansthan is giving a ray of hope to the homeless poor and helpless children through its "KIDS" project. The organization runs a school to fulfill their academic needs of such children through the project. This school gives them free education, uniforms, slippers, dinner, sweets, etc, to make their life better. The students come back with some moments of happiness and joy to themselves.

REKS also found that some of the children go outside to earn and involved in anti-social activities. Then REKS met the family members of such children and tried for them the legal counseling. We contacted them in house or running other child care centers to get their better behaved and good element. In result, it associated with the point to be that the children are quite interested in activities and during that they are living a better life.

REKS also took initiative to join our children to the mainstream of education for their good development. We again contacted their parents and persuaded them to send their children to schools and made them understand the importance of education in the life. Then, the parents started sending their children at schools in the educational development which REKS supported completely.

REKS also organized poster making competition, songs competition and other cultural programs for each participant which they participated thoroughly and enjoyed.

"Be Free ~ Be Happy ~ Be Smiley"

Rejeshan Sangam Kalyan Santhan runs numerous welfare projects for public health. In which we had organized free camps at various centers. We have done many such camps in various parts of India with overwhelming popularity.

They still have not been removed which is common place of both upper poor, etc. with the maximum percentage of their patients having various health disorders that makes them suffering from various diseases.

RSKR undertake the community aware of the various basic, organized "Be Free ~ Be Happy ~ Be Smiley" program. Under the program, we can help people to help them aware what do they have to live healthy, happy and how to make changes in their life and their health related topics with activities at the grassroots. RSKR has trained more than 2000 auxiliary workers who are giving away free health care services.



T.B., MDR

Under the supervision, RSKR has provided dietary, nutritional, patients of MDR & XDR T.B patient. The protein diet includes eggs, pulses, protein, a, protein bars, etc. That is given to the patients. This helps the patients to have better recovery.

Kill Malaria

Under the supervision managed by RSKR, we have provided various medicines to increase people's health and eliminate mosquito bites to give healthy. The community was educated about the disease spread by the vector and various ways to kill the mosquito and prevent its spread.

RIMS, in alliance with units of such 40 women and children distributed Dabur Chyawanprash so that they may have received in time which they don't get from food by consuming Dabur Chyawanprash, these children got enhanced immunity and gradually recovered their health.

Safe Motherhood (SUMA)



Important: Every pregnant woman deserves to have a safe delivery. In SUMA, the term "safe motherhood" means that pregnant women receive the community services of the health system that can assure that mothers and their babies be safe and healthy.

Disaster Recovery & Management

Barmer Flood Relief



Rechristian Social Church Kalyan Godwin organized the relief program to provide aid to the victims of natural disaster that affected all over. The heavy rainfall in the winter season last year resulted in the 4.5 million affected families and their dependents that affected about 2000 people of Barmer, Sardarpur and Jalore.

RKSC organized the emergency relief work in collaboration with the local administration. The relief work was conducted in four phases. After consulted with Dr. Patel, we have arranged relief for the security of the children and children under 10 years old. The main motto of the relief work is to help the people.

In the second phase, we allotted 10000 rupees. Donated to the victims families so that they might be able to purchase the essential items and cook the healthy meal. Also, we distributed the packed pulses and oil for the families.

In the third phase, we distributed 10000 rupees to the families so that they might be able to purchase the essential items. In this phase, we distributed blankets to 6000 families. Also, we distributed ration cards given to them from the government. The victim families have a smile on their faces because of the support from the organization.

In the fourth and last phase, we prepared an relay model between us. RKSC has arranged 300+ families and gave 1000 rupees to each family to earn daily. In this phase, we also what helped the families who lost their possession in the flood. All the funds collected were utilized for the relief. RKSC was so much effort to be made at the post-disaster relief works concerning food collection.

Operation Humanity

The main objective of the project managed by RSKS is to create sustainable self-reliance among the rural families who live in a poverty stricken area. Under this program, RSKS provides training to help these rural women earn enough income to ensure the food security of those women. We gave them 100% produce like, pulses, maize, soap, milk and vegetables, etc.

Our targeted group members RSKS took their training seriously, maintaining high standards of discipline both in the classroom and practical area. At the end, they now have every day more and more variety of pulses and fruits. RSKS also makes these free herbs at their gardens as well as and sell on individual cost basis or in packages of 1kg. These women say that currently all their living needs and their children's education is taken care of which gives them a sense of hope and progress.

In addition to this, RSKS organized 100 groups of women directly by the government and spent an additional 100000 rupees on their incentives. RSKS provided training to the groups in various areas to build their skills and local economy.






